No sale or distribution of goods or material.

	Beverages - Alcohol	 The BRC is a licensed venue, alcoholic beverages must not enter or exit the premises It is an offence for minors to purchase or consume alcohol or persons to supply alcohol to minors. Intoxicated persons will be refused entry and evicted from the venue
×	Beverages - Other	 Soft drinks or other beverages Thermoses containing tea and coffee
×	Cameras and recording equipment	 Lenses greater than 250mm Video – non-commercial only unless issued with Media Accreditation



Items used as a weapon



- Musical instruments
- Other prohibited items

Clothing & footwear

Animals

- Potential weapons knives, chains, studs
- Balloons, ball and chain (buck's parties), confetti or shredded paper
- Chemicals, radioactive or biological substances
- Loud hailers, megaphones, musical instruments
- Crockery, illegal substances, unsealed bottles, cans, glass containers, laser pointers, fireworks, items that display political or offensive messages, chairs/stools, flags/banners
- Patrons wearing or otherwise displaying inappropriate or unauthorised commercial, political, religious or offensive images/logos may be denied entry into the venue
- Patrons with bare feet will not be permitted entry
- No animals are permitted (horses excepted at correct entry point)

ALLOWED

- Bags and esky restrictions
- Beverages Other
- Eskies permitted in the Public Lawn area only (maximum dimensions) 35cm x 20cm x 30cm)
- Bags need to be less than A4 paper size
- Bags and other items may be subject to inspection and patrons may be searched. Patrons who refuse to comply maybe denied entry
- Sealed water only
- Patrons may bring homemade food items into the venue provided they





Animals

Tickets

are sitting on the Public Lawn (food for under 2 year olds excepted, medical reasons excepted; e.g. celiac, diabetic, food allergies etc.)

- Strictly no commercial food
- Birthday, Christmas, wedding presents and raffle prizes are allowed
- Consumable gifts are permitted as long as not consumed on premises

• Assistance dogs including service & support dogs

• Patrons may not be permitted entry if their tickets are damaged or defaced
